# SUNDAY, September 18th, 2016 25<sup>th</sup> SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: Amos 8:4-7

The prophet Amos expressed disgust over people who take advantage of the poor. He describes businessmen scheming to cheat the poor, then declares that God will "never forget the things they have done."

## Second Reading: 1 Timothy 2:1-8

Paul urges the Christians to pray for all people, especially those in authority. Paul even asked them to pray for the kings who denounced Christ's teachings, because God wants all people to be saved through Jesus.

## **Gospel: Luke 16:1-13**

Jesus tells a story about a servant who tries to cheat his employer. The owner is impressed because he would do the same thing himself. Jesus then describes the importance of being trustworthy in small matters, as well as in greater ones. He then states that no one can serve two masters faithfully, so people cannot give themselves completely to both God and money.

## Deacons Preaching at Mass

"Without prejudice to the prescript of can. 765, presbyters and deacons possess the faculty of preaching

everywhere," (Code of Canon Law, can. 764).

I think it is important that our Deacons have opportunities to preach; a faculty given to them at their ordination and confirmed by the Code of Canon Law. Deacon Len Deo preached at the Masses last weekend and Deacon Al Frank will preach in October. The Deacons will continue preaching one weekend each month. I feel it is important that people hear about the faith from different voices and I look forward to hearing Deacon Al and Deacon Len preach at future Masses.

## After-Communion Meditation Hymn

"When the distribution of Communion is over, if appropriate, the Priest and the faithful pray quietly for some time. If desired, a Psalm or other canticle of praise or a hymn may also be sung," (United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, The General Instruction of the Roman Missal 88).

Last weekend we introduced an After-Communion meditation hymn. I feel that it is important for people to spend a few minutes in prayer and contemplation after receiving the Body and Blood of Christ. People should not be in a hurry to get to their cars. I believe that music can aid in that contemplation/prayer time and also help transition us from the Liturgy of the Eucharist back to the Liturgy of the Word before the final prayer and blessing.
