

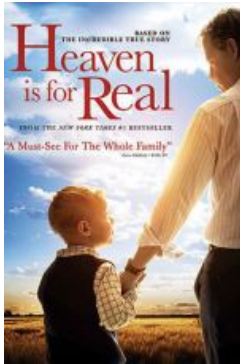

Heaven is for Real - Sat., Feb. 24 7:00 pm

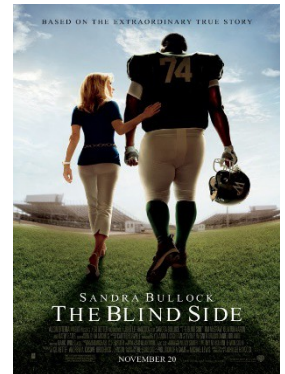

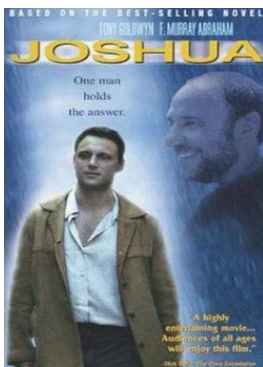
The Blind Side – Sat., March 10 at 7:00 pm
