In honor of the Lord's presence, our Sanctuary Lamp will burn this week, beginning November 6<sup>th</sup>, for the People of the Parish living and deceased.

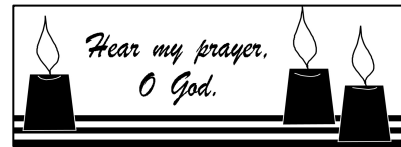

**First Reading: 2 Maccabees 7:1-2, 9-14**
