

MEET FATHER HERB

Through May 24, Msgr. Herbert K.Tillyer is serving as administrator of our parish while Father Tim is on sabbatical. Other than some different priests presiding at Mass and celebrating confession, Father Herb says we will see few changes during his tenure.

Father Herb is pastor of St. Peter the Apostle, the "mother church" of St. Ann in the sense that we were first a mission of that parish before we achieved our canonical status as a parish in 1982.

In addition to Father Herb, St. Peter has three other priests: Fathers Babu Thelappilly, Yojaneider Garcia Ramirez and Msgr. Christopher Di Lella.

Father Herb says he and the others are taking turns presiding at our weekend liturgies, as well as at daily Mass on Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesdays. Father Joe Murphy, who lives at Nazareth Village, will continue presiding on Thursdays. In the event of an after-hours emergency, when a priest is needed to celebrate the Sacrament of the Sick, parishioners should call St. Peter at (973) 334-2090.

Ordained a priest in 1968, Father Herb has been pastor at St. Peter since 1994. His appointment as St. Ann administrator is in addition to his pastor's duties. At a meeting with St. Ann staff, Father Herb defined his role as a "temporary administrator," who would not make changes but continue the practices and policies of Father Tim, who remains pastor.

Serving with other priests at St. Peter means all take turns presiding at the liturgies of the Sacred Triduum there. As a result, Father Herb says he has not presided at the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday for 20 years, so he is especially looking forward to presiding at our celebration on March 24.


